This bulletin is being issued to revise/clarify certain portions of the bidding documents, address a number of concerns and questions. This shall form an integral part of the bidding document for the above-stated project,.

Item No.	Comments/Queries/Concerns	Response					
1	Can the procuring entity consider "General Building" for the Classification of PCAB License?	Yes, as long as there is a Specialty-Waterproofing Work (SP-WP) in your PCAB License.					
2	In a contract like "Roofing and waterproofing", is only the portion/amount of waterproofing works can be accepted as a similar project?	Yes, even if you have a previous contract of construction or renovation of a building only the contract price for the waterproofing component will be considered on the SLCC.					
	Can the bidder combine different contracts of waterproofing works to get the 50% of ABC?	No, waterproofing components for a single project only will be considered, not the accumulation from different projects.					
3	Is "Painting and Waterproofing Works" accepted as a similar contract for SLCC?	No, only the waterproofing component will be considered as a similar contract on SLCC.					
4	For the PCAB Registration Particular, can it be "Small B" with a classification of "General Building" instead of "Waterproofing work (SP-WP)"? Also if higher than Trade/E is acceptable?	Yes, but the PCAB license should have a Specialty-					
5	With regards to the Certificate of Training Issued by or in coordination with BWC or DOLE of Safety Officer, Is this the usual COSH training certificate?	Yes.					
	Are the additional documents listed in clause	Organizational Chart for the contract to bid and Certification of Site Inspection shall be included in the bid;					
6	21 of Bid Data Sheet will not be included in the bid to be submitted?

7	With regards to the required waterproofing material, can you consider other waterproofing material that might be lower in price but equally or may surpass the quality of the required material?	The procuring entity will stick with Multi-co polymerized resin with nano silica as the required material to be used in this project.
8	One of the requirements in this project is the bidder must have an experience of using multi-co polymerized resin with nano silica, but most of the contractors like us usually use cement tissues or membrane in waterproofing, can it be considered?	Cement tissues or membrane waterproofing is not considered as a similar contract for SLCC. The entity will consider similar contract that used polymer waterproofing material
9	Can you give the brand of the required material?	No specific brand to be used.
10	There is no quantity in the Bill of Quantities, who will provide?	Please see "Annex A" for the revised Bill of Quantities
11	We would like to request a list of projects where the specified material has been used before for our reference.	List of Structures used same waterproofing material as specified in the project St. Lukes Hospital Department of Science and Technology (Main Bldg.) U.P Manila Manila City Hall Department of Public Works and Highways (Main) NAIA Bldg. Admin NAIA Terminal 2 Quirino Grand Stand NAIA Terminal 1 Philippine Heart Center



12	Can we send samples of other waterproofing material that can be used for projects?	The procuring entity will stick with Multi-co polymerized resin with nano silica as the required material to be used in this project.
13	Can you extend the given schedule?	We will stick to the original schedule as this project is urgent.
14	What is the area to be waterproofed?	It is the shaded portion in the drawings in pg. 47-48 of the bidding documents and other portions on the metal roofing.
15	We would like to clarify if the material is polyurethane?	No, the material for the waterproofing to be use is multi-co polymerized resin with nano silica
16	In terms of payment, is there a "Progress Billing" for this project? If there is, what are the requirements?	Yes there is a progress billing. We will follow the "Payments" under the terms of reference
17	In the Bill of Quantities, may we request to identify the details of its scope of work	Scope and details are already provided in the terms of reference, for additional details of bill of quantities please see "Annex A"
18	Are we getting permits from City Hall for waterproofing?	Yes, the contractor will facilitate all necessary permits.
19	Why is there an excavation?	Because there is a small portion that needs excavation to access the downspouts to the main drainage.
20	What will happen if the estimated area exceeds or there is lack of material to be provided?	Please see "Annex A" for the revised Bill of Quantities
21	How many years is the warranty? And is it from "Manufacturer Warranty" or "Contractors Warranty?	5 years Contractor's Warranty
22	Are the workers stay-in?	No.
23	Are you going to require a Swab Test for the workers?	Rapid Antigen Test is considered, either Rapid Antigen Test or Swab Test and the winning bidder will be given a health and safety protocol before the project commences.



24	Where is the hauling area? Do you still require a truck for hauling?	Truck is required for hauling because all existing waterproofing will be removed, hauled and disposed of. It is the responsibility of the contractor on where to dispose of all the debris.
25	Do we need to remove the metal roofing?	No, we don't have any removal of metal roofing. Only application of waterproofing on portions of the metal roofing.
26	With regards to the "Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government contract", does it mean we will just submit a list/statement or do we still need to submit the NOA, NTP or PO of the ongoing contract?	Yes, it's a list/statement but please attach receipt, NOA, or PO for evaluation purposes.
27	There is a requirement that we have to accomplish the detailed estimates, including summary sheets with unit prices and construction materials, the bidder will presume that whatever will be agreed upon as to the measurement with whoever will be the first to do the ocular as to the measurement will be the final to be included in the bid bulletin as to the Bill of Quantities that will be the basis of the prospective bidders for the area, material and the labor cost.	Please see "Annex A" for the revised Bill of Quantities
28	With regards to the PCAB License, our license is "Small B" is that okay?	Yes. Just make sure that the PCAB License has a Specialty-Waterproofing Work (SP-WP).
29	Where can we get the forms for SLCC and on-going and completed projects?	There is no prescribed form for the "Statement of Single Largest Completed Contract" and "Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started".
