8	<p>For Desktop Workstation Computers "Power Supply: 850W Gold"</p> <p>May we request to relax it into 750W as long as this is suitable with the power of the desktop specially the graphics card. And also our offer is still gold PSU.</p>	<p>No, at least 850W is required for the Power Supply</p>
9	<p>For Desktop Workstation Computers, "Speaker: 2.0 (stereo), USB powered"</p> <p>For clarification, is this an external USB desktop speaker? Do you consider third party brands?</p>	<p>Updating the response from Bid Bulletin No. 1 to</p> <p>Yes, it is an external USB Desktop Speaker.</p> <p>Yes, the bidder may offer a third party brand with spatial audio.</p>
10	<p>For Desktop Workstation Computers, "Webcam: Full-HD resolution and built-in microphone"</p> <p>Do you consider third party brands?</p>	<p>Yes, the bidder may offer a third party brand with a Full-HD resolution and built-in microphone</p>
